All proceeds will go directly to our new trophy case, athletic championship banners, and gym equipment.

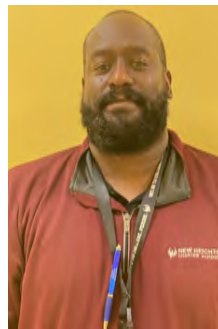

What has been your most impactful experience at NHCSB so far?

With Athletics getting off to a late start I was blown away by the number of scholars and parents that showed up for Soccer Tryouts. Most Schools started preparing for the Soccer Season last Spring. Most schools had their 1st practice or Tryouts August 23rd.

NHCSB had our tryouts Sept 13th & 14th and over 65 scholars found their way to George Snow Park. As of Sept 15th we now have Boys & Girls Varsity and a Co-ed Middle School team.

Due to the current bus shortage, limited number of soccer officials and Charter League schedules having to be submitted by Sept 15th, it has been a challenge to create a schedule. We will squeeze in as many games as possible and it's still be an exciting season.

Where do you see our athletics program one year from now?

In a year from now we will have extremely competitive Soccer, Basketball and Track Teams on both the Boys and Girls Varsity levels. We will introduce Volleyball in the Fall, Competitive Cheerleading in the Winter and Weight Training in the Spring.
